- The survey is an assessment to gather feedback from Executive Cabinet on leadership effectiveness, communications, and overall satisfaction with onboarding and with the ASCSU governance experience.

- About half of all Executive Cabinet members responded but they want to aim for all members to provide their input.
- Onboarding success
  - o 20 members had successful onboarding processes
  - o 4 members had unsuccessful onboarding processes
- Common obstacles (areas members would like more guidance on)
  - o 1. Lack of role clarity and expectations
  - o 2. Communication and feedback
  - o 3. Training gaps
- Areas of improvement for Executive Leadership
  - o 28% - Cabinet
  - o 26% - Expectations of departments
  - o 21% - Professional development
  - o 15% - Weekly communication
  - o 9% - Other
  - o 2% - None
